IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR MRF PARTICIPANTS

ITEMS TO BRING TO MARMARTH:

- Alarm clock
- Work clothes (We get pretty dirty. Recommended: long- and short-sleeve cotton shirts and long pants for field work; shorts are all right for lab work, free time and, if you wish, for field work.)
- Boots and good socks for field work (sneakers should not be worn in the field!)
- A hat, preferably with a wide brim, which provides sun protection
- Sunglasses, optional, but strongly recommended for UV protection
- Water bottle or canteen for fieldwork (each person must carry water – plan to carry two quarts).
- Backpack or book bag for day trips (not a hand-carried bag).
- Gloves for hand protection
- Personal toilet articles, soap, shampoo, medications
- Camera (and a zip lock bag to protect it from dust)
- Notebook and any reading material you like. A good reference book to buy is *Dinosaurs Under the Big Sky* by Jack Horner (2001), available at amazon.com for \$10-14.
- Sunscreen, chapstick, insect repellent and sunglasses (optional)
- An iPod or personal CD or tape player (optional)
- If you are very sensitive to dusty conditions you may require a respirator



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

A washer and dryer are available at the bunkhouse where you will be staying. If you are staying for more than one week you may want to bring some detergent, dryer sheets, and quarters.

The bunkhouse has all the bedding, towels and faceclothes you will need.

Please bring emergency contact information with you.

You will be able to use a laptop with WiFi.

The bunkhouse phone can be used to make long distance calls only if you have a calling card. It is difficult to pick up a cell phone signal in Marmarth. Verizon is the only service provider which people have been able to use.
